Dr. Aron J. Hall, DVM, MSPH, Dipl ACVPM, is a Deputy Director for Science of the Coronavirus and Other Respiratory Viruses Division (CORVD) at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, USA. He received bachelor's and master's degrees in public health from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and a doctorate of veterinary medicine from North Carolina State University. Dr. Hall's work at CDC has focused on the epidemiology, prevention, and control of viral diseases, including building and leading the norovirus epidemiology program, and helping to lead emergency responses and ongoing programs to address emergent coronavirus diseases (MERS and COVID-19). He is a recognized expert in the field, providing consultation within CDC, to state and local health departments, regulatory agencies, advisory committees, and international partners. Dr. Hall has authored over 200 journal articles and book chapters, holds adjunct faculty appointments at the Rollins School of Public Health of Emory University, and is a diplomate in the American College of Veterinary Preventive Medicine (ACVPM).
