

Dr. Joseph Bresee

Dr. Joseph Bresee is the Director of the Respiratory Virus Prevention Branch at the Task Force for Global Health. He oversees the Partnership for Influenza Vaccine Introduction and other programs that support immunization programs and surveillance for respiratory viruses. Dr. Bresee worked at US CDC from 1993 – 2021, during which time he directed programs focused on a variety of viral diseases, including enteric viruses, such as rotavirus and respiratory viruses. He led the Epidemiology and Prevention Branch of the CDC's Influenza Division from 2005-2017 and served as the Associate Director for Global Health Affairs from 2017-2021. He also regularly participates in national and international meetings and technical groups on immunization and influenza. Dr. Bresee has authored more than 300 peer-reviewed papers and textbook chapters.
