Dr. Nada Ghosn is the head of the Epidemiological Surveillance Program (Esumoh) at the Lebanese Ministry of Public Health. She is involved in enhancing the performance of communicable diseases surveillance system and outbreak investigation, and building national capacity. During the COVID-19 pandemic, she was leading the national team in charge of COVID-19 surveillance, investigation, contact tracing, and generation of the national daily COVID-19 surveillance report. Since 2022, she is leading the surveillance investigation of Cholera outbreak in Lebanon. Dr. Ghosn is contributing to the Mediterranean programme for Intervention Epidemiology Training (MediPIET), in which Esumoh is designated as MediPIET training site. Since 2022, she is leading the Lebanon Field Epidemiology Training Program, implemented with the support of the Eastern Mediterranean Public Health Network (EMPHNET). Dr. Ghosn has contributed to various WHO missions (training, review, GOARN). She is also a lecturer at Lebanese University, Faculty of Public Health since 2010. In Oct 2022, she was awarded the Lebanese second class of the Order of Merit for her contribution to COVID-19 surveillance and control. Dr. Ghosn is a medical doctor specialized in medical public health, graduating from the University of Lille II.
