MERS-CoV Technical Lead for WHO

Dr. Sophie von Dobschuetz is a veterinary epidemiologist with a PhD in Parasitology and International Animal Health from the Free University in Berlin, Germany and an MSc in Veterinary Epidemiology and Public Health from the Royal Veterinary College in London, UK. From 2004 to September 2022 she has worked for the Animal Health Service of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) to support countries in early warning, early detection, and the prevention and control of infectious animal diseases, with a focus on zoonoses such as avian influenza,

She currently holds the position of WHO's technical lead for Middle East respiratory syndrome coronavirus (MERS-CoV) and other novel coronaviruses for the Emerging Diseases and Zoonoses team at WHO headquarters. As MERS-CoV Technical Lead for WHO, Dr. von Dobschuetz supports countries in disease prevention and control, application of interdisciplinary and cross-cutting approaches, risk assessment and serves as focal point for inter-agency collaboration.
