Infectious Disease Epidemiologist, Influenza and Other Respiratory Viruses' Data Management and Evidence, World Health Organization's Global Influenza Programme in Geneva, Switzerland

Dr. Stefano Tempia is an infectious disease epidemiologist leading the influenza and other respiratory viruses' data management and evidence as well as the burden of disease estimation workstreams at the World Health Organization's Global Influenza Programme in Geneva, Switzerland. During the past 16 years of his work, he has focused on influenza and other respiratory viruses' surveillance and operational research, including burden of disease estimation. He has co-authored several publications assessing the disease and economic burden of influenza and other respiratory viruses at national, regional and global levels. His work has contributed to the development and refinement of the WHO guidelines (manual) for influenza disease burden estimation. He holds a PhD in Epidemiology and Biostatistics from the Colorado State University, USA; MSc in Epidemiology from the Institute for Tropical Medicine, Belgium; and Doctor in Veterinary Medicine, University of Pisa, Italy.
