Dr. Ziad Memish MD, FRCPC, FRCPE, FRCPL, FACP, FFPH, is a senior consultant in infectious diseases and Director of Research & Innovation Center at King Saud Medical City, Ministry of Health. He is a Professor at the College of Medicine in Alfaisal University, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, and an Adjunct Professor in the Hubert Department of Global Health at the Rollins School of Public Health, Emory University, Georgia, USA. Professor Memish is widely recognized as a pioneer in Mass Gathering Medicine and Infection Control and established the WHO collaborating center for mass gathering medicine in the Ministry of Health and WHO Collaborating Center for Infection Control in the Saudi Ministry of National Guard (Health Affairs). He is Board certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine, the American Board of Infectious Diseases, and is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (Canada, Edinburgh and London) and the American College of Physicians. On a national level, he is the Chair of the national scientific technical advisory group for COVID-19 and the Chair of the technical advisory group on COVID-19 vaccine under the Royal Court. Professor Memish obtained his MD from the University of Ottawa, Ottawa, Canada in 1987.
